PERU: It is nearly twenty years since the Parish Peru Project was launched. The reason for choosing this particular project for the millennium was due to the fact that all money went to the project without any overheads. Fr Alex who spearheaded the project came to visit us on two occasions. He constantly keeps us informed of all the good work. During this time three people from the Parish visited the Mission. Our Parish is a Missionary Parish and whenever we can we offer our support. The Peru Project is central to our mission concern regarding the wider Church. In terms of fundraising we still receive money from the 'Tea & Coffees', biscuits and cakes after the 11am Mass. We have lost a few volunteers now. Should anyone wish to help that will be very much appreciated. In the meantime I would like to acknowledge the generosity of those volunteers who continue to provide us with teas, coffees and cakes on a Sunday morning. Other generous donors have been supporting the project by giving regular donations (in cash or cheque). Other donations are received anonymously in the Peru Box at the back of the Church. I would like to acknowledge their generosity. Perhaps now it is time to find some ingenious ways to continue to raise funds for this mission.
