<u>GUIDANCE FOR CHURCHES – JANUARY 2022</u>: <u>GUIDANCE FOR OUR PARISH</u>. The general guidance was attached to the newsletter. A KEY sentence in the guidelines is, "This holding in tension to live safely with Covid 19".

In the light of these instructions the following are to be observed in the Parish.

- 1) <u>Continued practice of wearing a face covering</u> (both nose and mouth)

- 5) HOLY WATER STOUPS to be used.
- 6) HAND SANITISING: (Unless exempt) hand sanitizing is retained.
