GUIDANCE FOR CHURCHES – JANUARY 2022: GUIDANCE FOR OUR PARISH. The general guidance was attached to the newsletter. A KEY sentence in the guidelines is, "This holding in tension to live safely with Covid 19".

In the light of these instructions the following are to be observed in the Parish.

- 1) **Continued practice of wearing a face covering** (both nose and mouth)
- 2) **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** It is felt necessary to reserve a few seats where a distance could be found. There will be three front seats found in the main body of the Church where distance will be observed and two back seats in the Crying Chapel. These are marked with a gold ribbon.
- 3) As from this weekend (29/30th January) Hymn books, mass books, and other worship aids will be in use.
- 4) Readers & Ministers of Holy Communion (Lay people) are being invited to minister once again. They should still sanitise their hands for the distribution of Holy Communion.
- 5) **HOLY WATER STOUPS** to be used.
- 6) **HAND SANITISING:** (Unless exempt) hand sanitizing is retained.
