**Racial Justice Sunday:** This weekend Sun 9 Feb 2020 the Catholic Church in England and Wales will celebrate Racial Justice - the Theme is: "You are at the heart of the Church" It will celebrate the contribution Travelling communities make to the Church. It is an opportunity for all Catholics to pray for, reflect on and respond to Racial Justice matters within the Church and wider society. Racial Justice Sunday should encourage proactive discussions on overt and covert forms of racism experienced by fellow Catholics from the Travelling communities. To support the Church in its work with Travellers, a second collection will be taken next weekend. Your contributions, however great or small will help make a difference.

**PRAYER MEETING:** We are looking forward to start a prayer meeting on the lines of study, reflection and prayer. The area of silent prayer will be explored. At this stage I want to know how many are interested to explore the contemplative life of prayer. We had such meetings in the past. They were well supported. The time from Monday to Friday is 8.30am to 9.00am. On Saturday from 9.30am to 10.00am. You may wish to join us. This is a time to experience His Sacramental presence.

**SCHOOL MASS:** This Sunday 9th February at 11.00am we join the school children in the Eucharistic Liturgy (MASS). I would like to take this opportunity to encourage every family with school children to participate in the Sunday liturgy. I look forward to see every child in our school St Anselm's to participate fully in this Sunday liturgy of the Mass. This is a time where we show our common witness as a parish family. This encouragement is for both the infant and the junior section of the school. The Parish is made up of an amalgamation of small communities coming together to meet in Christ's name.
