SEA SUNDAY 2016: (AOS) (2ND COLLECTION) The Apostleship of the Sea is a Catholic charity, supporting seafarers worldwide. They provide practical and pastoral care to all seafarers, regardless of nationality, belief or race. Port chaplains and volunteer ship visitors welcome seafarers, offer welfare services and advice, practical help, care and friendship. The Apostleship of the Sea in Great Britain is part of an international network known to the maritime world as Stella Maris, working in more than 250 ports around the world. 90% of world trade is transported by ship. However the life of a modern seafarer can be dangerous and lonely. They may spend up to a year at a time away from home, separated from their family and loved ones and often working in harsh conditions. The AoS relies wholly on voluntary contributions, and can only continue its work through the generous donations of its supporters, particularly in this collection. This weekend a second collection will take place to support this apostolate.

1st HOLY COMMUNION 2017: This is the time of the year when we start planning for the next year's Holy Communion. This year we have seen a marked increase in the number of children receiving the Sacrament of the Eucharist. It is important to remind you that our parish programme is a two year programme. This applies to all children who wish to make their first Holy Communion, whether they attend a Catholic School or not. The preparation for the sacrament starts in Year 2. The first year the children will attend the Bible Club. Here they explore some of the main events in the Old Testament to provide them with a background to the New Testament. In the New Testament Jesus gives us the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Eucharist. For the parents who were unable to attend the meeting there is still time to enroll their child or children. The enrolment Forms are to be found at the back of the Church by the blue notice board. Once the form is filled it is to be returned to the Presbytery. May I remind parents that there is a time limit for applying.

BIBLE CLUB: The Parish first Holy Communion Programme is a two year programme. In the first year the children will attend the Bible Club. This starts in Year 2. Forms are to be found at the back of the Church.
