<u>THE EUCHARIST</u>: The Eucharist is the summit of our Catholic Worship. It is an authentic act of worship of the <u>real presence of Christ in the Eucharist</u>.

Christ presence beckons for a deep sense of reverence. There are a number of ways to show such reverence, (a) Prepare for Mass by arriving five minutes before the Mass, (b) By using the Mass book prayers before and after Mass. These prayers are to be found at the front and the back of the Mass book. Approaching the altar to receive communion, please make sure you place the host on your tongue before returning to one's place. One is encouraged to participate in the singing and the responses. The Eucharist is an act of Common Worship. Punctuality is an act of respect for a higher order (God). It is part and parcel of the social and religious etiquette. This is an integral part of our worship.

**CHRISTIAN UNITY OCTAVE**: (18th-25th January 2024) The Church Unity Octave was first observed in January, 1908. Celebrated in the chapel of a small Atonement Franciscan Convent of the Protestant Episcopal Church, on remote hillside fifty miles from New York City, this new prayer movement caught the imagination of others beyond the Franciscan Friars and Sisters of the Atonement to become an energetic movement that gradually blossomed into a worldwide observance involving many nations and millions of people. Christ prayed "that they all may be one". Let us pray for this unity of faith during this Octave.
