<u>SEASON OF LENT</u>: The season of Lent started in the third century and is believed to have started before. The three aspects of Lent are, 1) Penance, Prayer and almsgiving. In imitation of Christ's forty days in the desert and the forty years crossing the Jews crossing the desert from slavery to freedom the church sets the scene for three years lent. This devotion helps us to follow Jesus on his way to Calvary. The fourteen stations provide us with a great deal of thought to have a close look at the suffering of Christ. In life we carry our personal and his cross for the wh. Christ carries His Cross for the whole of humanity from the beginning of time till the end of time. A great deal to meditate about.
