DAY for LIFE: This is the Day in the Churches Life dedicated to celebrating the Sacredness of Life. The proceeds from the Day for Life collected provide core funding for the Anscombe Bioethics Centre (formerly the Linacare Centre for Healthcare ethics), and to assist other life related activities supported by the Church usually by means of grants made to support Catholic charities working in particular field determined by the theme of the year.

1st HOLY COMMUNION 2017: This is the time of the year when we start planning for the next year's Holy Communion. This year we have seen a marked increase in the number of children receiving the Sacrament of the Eucharist. It is important to remind you that our parish programme is a two year programme. This applies to all children who wish to make their first Holy Communion, whether they attend a Catholic School or not. The preparation for the sacrament starts in Year 2. The first year the children will attend the Bible Club. Here they explore some of the main events in the Old Testament to provide them with a background to the New Testament. In the New Testament Jesus gives us the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Eucharist. A meeting has been arranged for this **MONDAY 20TH JUNE at 6.30PM** for parents of children who would be first communicants. Parents are asked to fill the appropriate form which you find on the table at the back of the Church. May I remind parents that there is a time limit for applying.
