#### **Admission to Reception Class for September 2019:**

If you have a child born between 01/09/14 and 31/08/15 you can apply now for a place in the Reception Class at St Anselm's Catholic Primary School.

You will need to complete a Supplementary Information Form (SIF). The SIF is available from the school office or you can download a copy from the school website [www.st-anselms.kent.sch.uk](http://www.st-anselms.kent.sch.uk). All completed SIFs must be submitted to St Anselm's Catholic Primary school by the 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

You will also need to complete a local authority online application form via [www.kent.gov.uk/ola](http://www.kent.gov.uk/ola). The online application process opens on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018 and closes on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

Please note **both forms must be completed.**

An Admissions Meeting will be held on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018 at 10.00am in the school hall. Mrs White, the Headteacher, will explain the admissions process and talk about the school.
