### **NOVEMBER DEAD LIST:**

Please return, with the names of those you wish to have remembered throughout November at Holy Mass for the repose of your Holy Souls and the Souls who are almost forgotten, even those of whom we may now have happy memories together with your offering and support of your priest.

**THIS IS OUR LAST ACT OF CHARITY FOR THOSE GONE BEFORE US.**

**A PLENARY INDULGENCE**, applicable only to the holy souls, may be gained once in any church either on All Souls Day, or the preceding or following Sunday or on the Feast of All Saints. Viz On the usual conditions, a visit to a church, where the Our Father and creed are recited, Sacramental Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the Holy Father's Intention. Those who visit a cemetery between 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> November and pray for the faithful departed may obtain a plenary indulgence, applicable to the Holy Souls.

**BLESSING OF GRAVES:** On Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> November there will be a blessing of graves at Watling Street Cemetery. The service starts at 2.30pm.

**ALL SAINTS DAY:** Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November is the feast of All Saints. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. There is a Vigil Mass on Monday 31-October at 7.00pm. On Tuesday the timetable is as follows: Parish Church: 10.00am & 7.00pm, Darent Valley Hospital: 12.30pm.

**ALL SOULS DAY:** A short memorial service will take place on WEDNESDAY at our memorial. This service will be followed by Mass at 9.00am. Other Masses are said during the day. Please consult the newsletter.
